

The 3+1 program is built upon the student having **64** completed hours as part of the AAS degree at COD prior to the student beginning their Lewis courses.

Lewis does not run courses over the summer, but the additional third-year COD credit may be taken during the summer semesters.

All College of DuPage courses must be completed the semester <u>prior</u> to the student's last Lewis semester. **Students may** <u>not</u> be enrolled in any COD courses while in their Lewis graduating semester.
